

Australian Off Road Championships Rounds 7 & 8, Conondale QLD

On the 19 and 20th of May, Rosie Lalonde competed once again in the AORC, as the championship moved to the fabulous raceway in Conondale, QLD. The weekend proved to be quite successful for Rosie, as she moved up one step on the Championship Women's overall podium and now sits 2nd overall behind Alison Parker.

Saturday saw competition heat up for Rosie and QLD female racers Jemma Wilson and Jacqui Beattie. All three girls were close all day over the two challenging tracks. The format of the race saw the riders race 8 heats over the day, split between an MX test and an Enduro Test. Struggling slightly with the open, fast motocross test, Rosie ended the day in 4th position.

Sunday fared better however, as Rosie relaxed and held 2nd position most of the day. Wilson catching her only on the last lap, Rosie was extremely happy to finish the day in 3rd place.

"I was really happy with my results this weekend. I had an awesome battle all weekend with the QLD ladies and it was great because I haven't been able to race that closely with anyone in the series yet. The MX test was challenging for me, as motocross isn't my strong point, but I made up time on
